SPCB TOPICS: Kelli Okuma

- 1) New Board Member installed – Terrell Ferreira (give brief bio?)
- 2) Dennis Patzer rejoining SPCB as retired annuitant - duties as of Jan. 2007
- 3) DCA (& SPCB) moving to new location (Arden Way/Royal Oaks) – September, 2007
- 4) Structural Fine Increase – Effective as of September 24, 2006 16 CCR 1922
 - a. Notice sent out early October to CACs by SPCB
- 5) Changes to Occupant's Fumigation Notice:
 - a. Currently check boxes to indicate which fumigant is to be used (Methyl Bromide or Vikane), changes will be made to indicate other Sulfuryl Fluoride products, such as Zythor.
- 6) Changes to Fumigation Log:
 - a. Property description is to include specifics of any connecting structure
 - b. Check boxes to indicate which dosage calculation method currently only reflect methods for Vikane; changes will be made to indicate methods used to calculate for Zythor and other generic SF products
- 7) Committee updates: (?) all have some impact on CACs/DPR
 - a. Laws & Regulations review
 - b. Pre-treat
 - c. Water Quality
- 8) DFG Trapping Exemption for Branch 2's?

"FUMIGATION" RELATED ISSUES (Branch 1):

- 1) ZYTHOR REGISTRATION -
 - a. Registered on October 27, 2006
 - b. Aeration / clearance levels are 1 ppm vs
 - c. Vikane's aeration / clearance levels at 5 ppm
 - d. Existing TRAP program to be used with either Zythor or Vikane
- 2) VIKANE - AMENDED LABEL – currently in registration review. Changes:
 - a. Aeration / certification at 1ppm
 - b. Ventilation of storage area, if cylinders are stored in occupied structure
 - c.

 - a. "Best practices" provisions with new 1 ppm aeration / certification levels
- 4) SF STEWARDSHIP PLAN – Jerry Campbell will address under "new business"
 - a. Proposed regulatory items
 - b. Proposal to list SF as a Toxic Air Contaminant, expected from OAL in early Dec.

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“GENERAL PEST CONTROL” RELATED ISSUES (Branch 2):

- 1) DFG TRAPPING EXEMPTION –
 - a. Structural and DPR licensees exempt from DFG licensing requirement for “rats, mice, voles, moles, and gophers”. Trapping all other nuisance wildlife requires DFG license, and adhering to DFG trapping requirements

- 2) HEALTHY SCHOOLS ACT – AMENDMENT re: CHILD DAY CARE CENTERS
 - a. Notification period to owner/operator = 120 Hours (5 days)
 - b. Ed Code – includes definitions, notification period, prohibited uses based upon registration status, written notification (CACs – have no oversight)
 - c. FAC – definition of IPM, voluntary adoption of IPM, IPM training program (DPR requirements)

 - a. Tentatively scheduled for March or April 2007
 - b. Questionnaire being sent to CAC deputies
 - c. Basic training, possibly a concurrent advanced session
